I am writing to inform you that Birmingham City Council (the Council) is publishing the following statutory proposal, in close collaboration with the leadership and governing body of Uffculme School (the School):

• Permanently increase the number of places the School can offer to pupils, from 204 to 266.

The School is a community special school rated 'Good' by Ofsted. The School has a capacity of 204 pupils. The School currently offers support to pupils with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

It is due to the steadily growing demand for this type of provision in Birmingham, the Council, working closely with the School making this proposal.

The statutory consultation for this proposal will last four-weeks from 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022 to 7<sup>th</sup> July 2022, this is known as the "representation period".
