

Examinations and Awards 2020

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This was a highly unusual year for examinations. Due to the national lockdown, there were no GCSE examinations and we were not able to complete the internally sat tests for the Entry level qualifications. Consequently, schools were asked to submit expected grades for Entry and GCSE qualifications. These were then standardised by the examining boards and adjusted up or down if necessary.

Our students were awarded the grades that staff had submitted.

Year 11

In 2019-20, Year 11 students followed predominately Entry level courses across four subjects (English, Mathematics, PE and Science). Some students followed the Transition Challenge course which focuses on personal and social skills. These were accredited at the end of Year 11 and have supported these students with their next steps in their education.
